NON- COMPLIANCE OF THE ORDER IN THE ABOVE CCP DATED 15.02.2019**

The above complainant filed the petition for execution contending that the respondent has not complied with the order passed in the above CCP filed by her.

2. Heard the counsel for petitioner/complainant. The learned counsel submitted that the respondent has neither preferred any appeal nor settled the amount due under the order in CCP to the petitioner and hence the execution of the order for recovery of the amount under the order to be made by this Forum.

3. Since the amounts due to the complainant under the order is to be recovered as arrears as land revenue, it is just and necessary to issue warrant under section 40(1) of the RERA Act. The EP is disposed accordingly.
