**ORDER FOR RECOVERY UNDER SECTION 40(1) OF THE RERA ACT READ
WITH RULE 26 OF TNRERA RULES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE
OF THE ORDER IN THE ABOVE CCP DATED 04.01.2022**

The above petitioner/order holder filed the petition for execution stating that the respondent/debtor have not complied with the order passed in the above CCP by this Forum. The respondent remained absent.

2. The counsel for petitioner/order holder submitted that the respondent has neither preferred any appeal nor settled the amount due under the order in CCP to the petitioner/order holder and hence the execution of the order for recovery of the amount under the order to be made by this Forum. By order dated 04.01.2022, this Forum directed the respondent, to pay the amount of

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compensation and cost. But the respondent has not settled the amount due as per the order.

3. Since the amounts due to the petitioner/order holder under the order is to be recovered as arrears as land revenue, it is just and necessary to issue warrant under section 40(1) of the RERA Act read with Rule 26 of the TNRERA Rules. The EP is disposed accordingly.

In the result, it is ordered as follows:

Issue recovery warrant under section 40 (1) of the RERA Act read with Rule 26 of TNRERA Rules and send it to the District Collector, Coimbatore to collect the amount to satisfy the claims under the order passed in favor of the above petitioner/order holder.
