**ORDER FOR RECOVERY UNDER SECTION 40(1) OF THE RERA ACT READ
WITH RULE 26 OF TNRERA RULES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE
OF THE ORDER IN THE ABOVE CCP DATED 25/01/2023**

1. The above complainant filed the petition for execution stating that the respondent has not complied with the order passed in the above CCP filed by them.
2. The respondent has not obtained any stay in the appeal if any preferred by the respondent before the Appellate Tribunal nor he has paid the amount due to the complainant in compliance of the order of this Forum.
3. In the above CCP, the respondent is directed to pay the complainant, the amount of Rs.53,51,141/- with interest @ 9.30 p.a as ordered in CCP No. 86 of 2021 dated 25/01/2023.
4. Since, the amount due to the complainant under the order is due and liable to be recovered, it is just and necessary to issue warrant under Section 40(1)
